

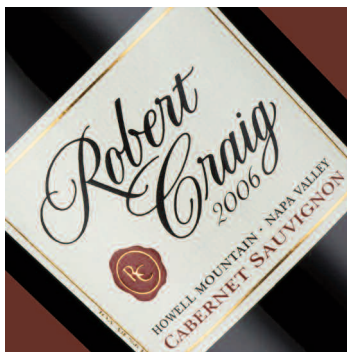

**Cabernet Sauvignons from Napa Valley that offer uniformly high quality**

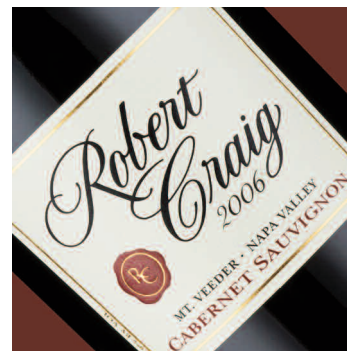
This flight of mountain- and hillside-grown Cabernets impressed me for its uniformly high level of quality. . . **Robert Craig's Cabernets from Howell Mountain and Mount Veeder were impressive for their balance and nuance.**



### **ROBERT CRAIG Cabernet Sauvignon HOWELL MOUNTAIN 2006**

**Score: 90**

**Rich and tannic**, with a beam of earthy dried currant, sage and savory berry and herb notes that are **firm and concentrated**. . . **everything is in place**. This just needs time to come around. Best from 2010 through 2016. 1,240 cases made. — J.L.



### **ROBERT CRAIG Cabernet Sauvignon MOUNT VEEDER 2006**

**Score: 90**

**Bordeaux-like** in its structure and character, with aromas of anise, currant, rose petal, cedar and blackberry. . . **Full-bodied, with excellent balance, depth and dimension**, ending with tight, ripe tannins. Best from 2010 through 2016. 1,700 cases made. — J.L.
